

The Institution of Geospatial and Remote Sensing Malaysia (IGRSM) successfully organised the 10th IGRSM International Conference and Exhibition on Geospatial & Remote Sensing (IGRSM 2020) on 20-21 October 2020. The conference was initially scheduled to be held on 17-18 March 2020 at Berjaya Times Square Hotel, Kuala Lumpur. 
